WORKSHOPS

The focus of the conference will be Long Term Recovery Committees (LTRC). Discover how your agency can effectively coordinate their efforts to help the most vulnerable survivors recover following a disaster. Who should be at the table, what steps should you take today to be better prepared, what model works for your community, how do you secure funding, what do those first meetings look like?

ACCOMMODATIONS

Camp Ida-Haven is run by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. It is located five miles from downtown McCall, Idaho.
